The team is comprised of geriatric psychiatrists - Dr Syeeda Salim, Dr Sheena Ghodasara, Dr Briana Howarth and Dr Temitayo Aboaba (joining February 2023). They are supported by nursing and allied health staff.

SERVICE CRITERIA	
AGE REQUIREMENTS	65+ years of age *age criteria is waived for requests for diagnosis and management of cognitive impairment and dementia

DIAGNOSTIC AND CLINICAL INFORMATION	<ul> <li>Individuals over the age of 65 years who are experiencing/require:</li> <li>Medication assessment for mental health concerns</li> <li>Late onset mental health symptoms</li> <li>Behavioural and psychological complications associated with dementia</li> <li>Long standing psychiatric disorders with age-related complications</li> <li>Medical and functional impairment with associated psychiatric and behavioural dysfunction</li> <li>Diagnosis and management of dementia</li> </ul> Referrals are prioritized as urgent for symptomology including: mania, suicidal ideation, responsive behaviours (aggression) associated with dementia, psychosis and psychotropic medication polypharmacy (3+psychoactive medications).
